This matter is before the Colorado State Personnel Board ("Board") at its regularly scheduled meeting held on June 16, 2020. During this public meeting, the Board considered the Preliminary Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge.

Based upon its review and consideration of the Preliminary Recommendation, the Board finds there is a sufficient basis to adopt the Preliminary Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge to grant the petition for hearing on Complainant's national origin/ancestry discrimination claim in violation of the Colorado Anti-Discrimination Act.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Preliminary Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge is adopted, and that the petition for hearing is **GRANTED** on the claim of a violation of the Colorado Anti-Discrimination Act but **DENIED** on the whistleblower claim.
