MEETING MINUTES

January 16, 2024

The State Personnel Board met on January 16, 2024. The Board held its meeting via webinar using Zoom. Members of the public attended the meeting. In advance of the meeting, the Board posted information on its website about the agenda and webinar.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. Board Members Kimberley Dempster, F. Robert Lee, David Ruchman, Euell Thomas, and Sarah Wager were present for the roll call. Jenna Anderson, Esq. (Board Counsel) and Rick Dindinger (Board Director) were also present.

I. REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & ADMINISTRATION (DPA) AND REPORT OF THE DIVISION OF HUMAN RESOURCES (DHR).

There was no report scheduled this month.

- II. REVIEW OF INITIAL DECISIONS OR OTHER FINAL ORDERS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES ON APPEAL BY THE PARTIES TO THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD.

- Dindinger recommended that the Administrative Law Judges change the sequence of the Preliminary Review sections so that the parties' information goes at the end rather than in the middle. The Board agreed with the recommendation.
- Dindinger recommended that the December Board Meeting be held on the third Tuesday in December (December 17). The Board agreed with the recommendation.
- Dindinger reported that the Administrative Law Judges offer parties the choice of holding evidentiary hearings via webinar using Google Meet or onsite at 1525 Sherman Street in the Board's courtroom.
- B. GENERAL COMMENTS FROM ATTORNEYS, EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS, PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATORS, AND THE PUBLIC.
 - In advance of the meeting, the Board did not receive any requests to make a general comment publicly.

Dindinger reminded the Board that it will be conducting a rulemaking hearing at the February meeting so Board Members should plan on a lengthier meeting than typical.
